#### THE NEW CHURCH PLANT

One of our mandates from our Lord is to plant new churches in the new areas where we are witnessing and we are very pleased to report to you that we were able to start a new church named Overcomers Baptist Church with the first service held on the 20th of September, 2020. We had a wonderful first service at the new church with 51 people in attendance and 6 professions of salvation! Bro. Akanji Emmanuel Ola who is one of our trained men

will be pastoring the church. Please be praying for the growth of this new church and for the pastor and his family. Also, we are having a lot of needs relating to the new church. One of the urgent needs are chair/benches. We are currently renting the benches we are using, and we are trusting the Lord to provide for this. Another important need is the monthly support for the pastor of the church. My family and I are currently supporting them from our own little support, and we are praying that God will raise this needed support of at least \$100 monthly for this pastor and the new church. Continue to pray with us on these needs!

Our main church here - Faith Baptist Church - is doing well and God is adding to us souls that are being saved after witnessing the Lord Jesus Christ to them! Continue to pray for our various outreaches - soul winning, drive-in film shows and so on!

#### SAFE HARBOR BAPTIST CHILDREN'S HOME

Our orphanage is going on well and all our children and house parents are doing fine!

Also, works are moving forward on our permanent site building projects. We are currently working on roofing the four buildings and we will be sharing some pictures of this with you in our subsequent prayer letters! Meanwhile, a married

couple who are longtime friends of our family and supporters of our ministry has donated \$10,000 to the Safe Harbor Orphanage in memory of their grandparents Lister and Shelia Moore from Prattville, Alabama and this has been committed to our buildings construction. Praise the Lord for this blessing!

The initial estimation for the completion of this project is put at \$360,000 including the land purchase and finishing of the office complex and homes for the orphans! We believe that we are currently at twenty five percent of the project and we are trusting the Lord to provide the remaining funds for us! We cannot but say a big thank you to everyone that had given specifically towards this project. May God continue to bless and prosper you all in Jesus Christ name. Amen!

### END OF THE YEAR PROGRAM FOR OUR ORPHANAGE

We always hold what we call Christmas/End of the Year Party for all the children of our orphanage including the widows and their children as well. This is when we buy clothes and shoes for our children and host a party for the entire Safe Harbor family and our children are always excitedly looking forward to this day. The date for this year's program is Tuesday December 29th, 2020. We are currently caring for 46 children (including the widows children) and our projection is that it will take an average of \$45 per child to buy clothes, shoes and food for the party which comes up to \$2,070. We are praying that God will provide for this need!

As I conclude, please continue to pray with us on the following:-

1. That God will continue to protect us and all our people and keep us safe from this ongoing

pandemic. For continuous good health for our family, provisions for all our needs and protections upon us!

2. That God will provide for the needs of the new church that we just started. We need fund to buy chairs or make benches. For God to provide the monthly support of \$100 for the pastor of the new church and his family, and also to buy a land/property in the near future!

3. That God will provide the \$2,070 needed to buy Christmas gifts for our orphanage and widows' children as well as for the food for our End of the Year Party!

4. For increase monthly support for our orphanage and widows' relieve ministry!

5. Continuous provisions for the needed funds to complete our ongoing orphanage buildings project!

6. For our Christian school – Safe Harbor Christian Academy – growth and sustainability!

Once again, thank you for your prayers and faithful support. May God continue to bless and replenish you in Jesus Christ name. Amen!
