We are praising God for
the wonderful times we
are enjoying in the ministries here! The
Lord is blessing His works in our hands
and we say GLORY TO GOD!!!

REPORTS FROM OUR CHURCHES:

We give thanks to God for His blessings
on Faith Baptist Church. Back in August
(9th-12th, 2021), we had our Vacation
Bible School and it was a great success.
We were averaging over 800 children
each day with cumulative attendance
of over 3,200 for the four days and we
recorded at least 700 making decisions
to receive Jesus Christ as their Savior!
Now, it is not just about the numbers
but we are grateful for the opportunities
we had to reach these children and
teenagers with the

gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ! We
believe that the seeds of the Word of
God planted in these precious souls
will not be in vain and that it will grow
unto fruitfulness!

In October (1st to 3rd), we held our
first three days conference for our
young people which we tagged "ARISE:
YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULTS
CONFERENCE". We had a good
turnout having an average of 160 youths
in attendance on each day and the Lord
moved mightily as we recorded several
salvation testimonies and many of
these young people rededicated their
lives unto Christ. Praise the Lord!

Church where I had the honor of preaching. We had 78 people in attendance and 6 people got saved on that blessed day! We praise the Lord for His sustaining grace on this new church and on Bro. Emmanuel Akanji and his family (our pastor at this church). Over the course of the first year of this church, we have recorded over 500 professions of faith through our soul winning and other outreach programs. The church is now averaging 45 people on Sunday morning. Continue to pray for this church. We need to buy a land for this church and also trust the Lord to have a church building built before their next anniversary! Join us in praying for this need.

We are also receiving great reports from our churches in the villages (Bethel Ind. Baptist Church of Abikehin and Ile-Isin

Ind. Baptist Church of Baluwe) and also from Bro. Josiah Afolabi in Ekiti State where we are planning to start another church in the city of Ado-Ekiti which is the state capital. Continue to pray for us on this as well.

SAFE HARBOR ORPHANAGE:

The permanent site project of our orphanage is going on fine. We mentioned in our last prayer letter about the commitment of one of our friends in matching a dollar for dollar up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000)! As at the end of October, we have received ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) from some of our supporting churches and friends. This means that we have twenty thousand dollars because of our friend's commitment. We are trusting the Lord to help us with the remaining forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to

complete our friend's commitment. We are humbly asking you to pray and ask the Lord what He will want you to give towards this project.

Even though we are already counting



our friend's commitment as being already done which means we need to raise \$40,000 and this will help us to complete the first phase of this project which are four buildings (3 buildings are five bedrooms each and the fourth building consist of 2 three bedrooms)! We are praying that we will be able to move our orphanage into this property on or before the end of July, 2022 when our current rent will end. Continue to pray with us on this!

CHRISTMAS FOR OUR ORPHANS:
We always hold Christmas/End of the Year party for our children at the

orphanage together with the children of our widows where we buy clothes and shoes for these children and have Christmas dinner for them and the entire Safe Harbor's family. This year's party will hold on Tuesday December 28th by the grace of God. The projected cost to buying the clothes, shoes and cook foods for 59 children (which is the number of our orphans) is \$2,360 and this comes to \$40 per child. We are trusting the Lord to provide for us to be able to do these this year. Please join us in praying for this need also!

FAMILY NEWS:

Our first daughter, Janice graduated from high school in August. She



finished with Abeka Homeschooling program and she even got an honor roll certificate for excellent performance. She wants to attend Pensacola Christian College in Florida. Join us in praying

for her in this next step of her life.

Isaiah and Nicole are doing fine and they are currently in 9th and 8th grades respectively. Ronke and I are also doing well. Thank you for your faithful support of our family and also for your prayers for us. We are very grateful!
